



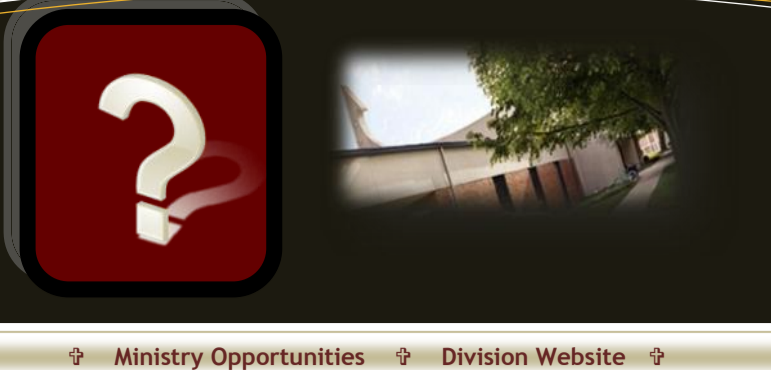

## Christian Ed: Laying the Foundation

Have you ever thought to yourself, "I could write curriculum like that," or wondered just how you could make a difference in a child's life? Whether you enjoy working behind the scenes or crave interaction with others; whether you would like to travel the globe or stay in the U.S.; if you want to minister to families or to children; no matter what your interests, there are many possibilities awaiting you as a Christian Education major. Just what kind of things does a Christian Ed major do after graduation? Glad you asked. One graduate is now working as a curriculum consultant at the United Methodist Publishing House in Nashville. Another graduate is a staff member with InterVarsity Christian Fellowship at Purdue University. Another serves as Head Teacher for ages four and five at the Child Development Center at Notre Dame University. Still another graduate recruits missionary volunteers for the Christian and Missionary Alliance World Headquarters. Yet another works for Youth for Christ. Some teach at Christian Schools on the mission field and in the U.S. Others work for the Salvation Army. By far, the most common vocational choice for Christian Education graduates is serving on a church staff as a Minister (or Director) of Christian Education or a Minister (or Director) of Children's, Youth, or Family Ministries.
