A Go with God Moment By Dr. David Smith

A "Go with God" moment,

Friends;

Do you remember Fall Summit? Do you remember Tuesday evening? Do you remember Dave Ward preaching from James 5:17-18¹⁷ Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years.¹⁸ Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops.

Know that the likeness which your professors share with Elijah is that we are men and women of prayer. Hear your professors, men and women; pray...biblically...for you, the students whom God has entrusted to our care, and for our entire campus.

- We pray for *harmony*; for unity is the ultimate prayer of Jesus (John 17:11);
- We pray for *other-centered minds*; for Christ calls us to mimic His model (Phil 2:5-11);
- We pray for *servant-like garments*; for a basin and towel are the business attire of a Christian leader (John 13);
- We pray for *the enlightening of minds*; for a Godly solution to this issue will certainly not be conceived by mere mortals (Eph 1:17-23);
- We pray for *mutually compatible visions*; which like the ones given to Cornelius (Acts 10:1-8) and Peter (Acts 10:9-16) do not make sense without the insight of each being shared communally in submission to God's Will.
- We pray for *broken and contrite hearts*; otherwise, how will God hear our prayers and heal us (2 Chron 7:14);
- We pray for *ears to hear and eyes to see*; for blindness to the proceedings of the Kingdom and deafness to the voice of God is the curse of all humanity; even those closest to Him (Mark 4:11-13; 8:17-21);
- We pray for *a passion to follow*, regardless of the destination, even to Jerusalem and to the cross (Mark 10:52; John 21:18-19);
- We pray for *individual and corporate holiness of heart*; for in this very process we will make our statement to the world of who we claim to be; may purity of heart reign. (John 17:13-19)

REL 481: Ministry Expansion and Church Planting
(Alternate course title: Missional Ministry and Expansion)

Calling all ministry students who have a heart to radically explore perceptions of effective ministry:

The ministry landscape is changing at a rapid pace. Church leaders must devise new ways of reaching people with a timeless message. People will not naturally arrive in the doors of a church. The church must go to them. Ministry effectively happens outside the walls of the church as the community of believers looks beyond itself.

This class will take students on a journey of discovery as we wrestle with the biblical mandate to "Go and make..." as it relates to starting new churches, transforming existing churches into sending communities and helping leaders transition to a more missional approach.

The class is being offered FALL of 2009 on Tuesday evenings in the Department of Religious Studies.



World Hope International will hold a workshop at IWU on Saturday October 25, while filming a training video. The instructional sessions are from 8:45 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Training topics led by Dr. Thom Kettelkamp from Houghton will include:

1. Serving for long-term results and expectations – What the volunteer will leave behind in the host country

3. Things you need to know while on the field – Disengagement and serving in the host country
4. Things you need to know when you get home – Reengagement into your culture and next steps

This is training that we have offered for a cost of \$200/person to longer-term volunteers and team leaders so this is quite a steal to have a opportunity to attend without paying for the training.
